

The Macquarie Gale Roman Scholarship 2008

Thanks to the generosity of the late Dr Bill Gale and Mrs Janet Gale, the Ancient History Department of Macquarie University is offering for the fourth year in a row a Scholarship to the prestigious British School at Rome for up to nine months starting from October, 2008 (timeframe slightly negotiable).

Conditions:

The successful scholar must be a PhD candidate at Macquarie in Ancient History or a recent postdoctoral scholar based at Macquarie (up to three years after the conferral of the degree). The scholarship will cover:

1. one return economy airfare from Australia to Rome (to be arranged through the University's official travel service)
2. Cost of subsistence in Rome (residence in the British School will be obligatory).

Applications due:

Please send your CV (two pages max. including list of publications), and a summary of your research project which must be broadly relevant to the history and archaeology of Rome, Italy or the provinces of the Roman Empire, with dates of your intended stay at Rome by Thursday 24 April to the Dept. of Ancient History, Div. of Humanities, Macquarie University, NSW 2109. You must include specific refereed publication outcomes as part of your application.
